As a class we are working on volume control. Often young children will yell when speaking not only to get our attention but so we can better understand their developing language. We would appreciate it if you would continue this at home. A great technique we use for volume control and interrupting is to say to the child "hold my hand until I can give you my attention." This way the child knows we've acknowledged them but that they need to wait their turn.
